BISD will have famous children's books authors visiting campuses during school hours to give students an opportunity to meet authors of books they have read. Authors will do literacy activities with students that will inspires and energize audiences to love and appreciate reading.

On May 21, community members are invited to an "Evening with the Authors," at the Brownsville Historical Museum on 641 E. Madison Street, from 4-7 p.m. The first 100 parents will receive a free book at the door. BISD is thrilled to announce the authors for this year's event will include Mike Thaler, Xavier Garza, and Lada Kratky.

Mike Thaler is a national children's book author, of over 200 published books of many well known and loved characters and is known as "America's Riddle King.". 
